AWEC Welcomes Regional Directors!

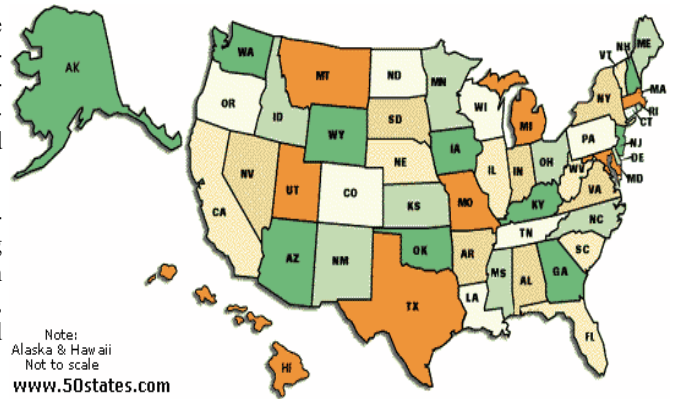
AWEC is happy to announce the appointment of its Regional Directors for the Mid-western, Western and Southern Regions of the United States.
